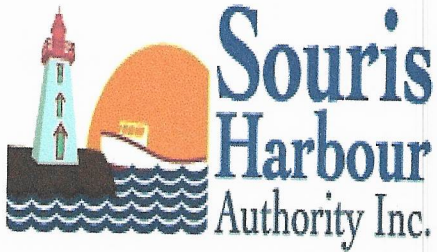

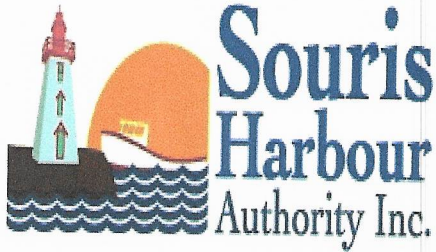

Calculation of Storage Area

Goods stored in or on Souris Harbour Authority properties will be charged in accordance with the posted rates from the initial time in which the goods are placed on or in port properties or buildings until the goods are completely removed. An initial area measurement will occur at the completion of storage and will be used to calculate the storage rate that will apply until the complete removal of the goods. There will be no deduction, setoff, or abatement of the storage rate for partial removal of the goods during the storage period. The storage rate will be charged on a daily rate basis from the commencement date of storage, whether or not all goods have been stored as of that date, and will be in effect until complete removal of the goods from SHAI lands.

A. Transfer of Garbage from International Ships must have prior approval of SHAI Office. Permits may or will be required, inspection may or will be required, and these issues are the responsibility of the vessel owner, captain, agent, or representative.
